Then, in September, our Global Mission ministry team will invite the congregation to purchase and gather up certain items to make up to 75 personal care kits for adults. Then lastly, on Sunday, October 15<sup>th</sup>, between our worship services – in the MPR - we will assemble these items together to make these kits. I hope you'll be there for that and witness how powerful God's people are when we're given the opportunities to work and serve together.




