A WORD FROM THE PASTOR

Beloveds of Our Saviour.

As I write this letter to you, we are in the middle of our Lenten Journey. I pray that you are doing well on your path toward the joy-filled celebration of Easter, our Lord's victorious resurrection. If you've chosen to follow and practice a spiritual discipline during this Lenten season, I hope that it's helping you draw closer and tighter to Jesus. As for

me, I've taken up the *discipline of silence* each day (3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.) to not talk, but to listen to God's "still, small voice" in and through my surroundings. I confess to you that the discipline of silence has proven to be a difficult one for me as I am a "talker". However, it has allowed me to be more intentional to "shut-up and listen" to what the Holy Spirit desires for me to hear. Pray for me!

Speaking of listening, not too long ago in our Tuesday, Bible Study class, I taught that without Easter, the Christian faith is a waste of time. I said this because of what the Apostle Paul wrote in his first letter to the Christian believers in Corinth, saying, "If Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins" (1 Corinthians 15:17). The reason for this is that Easter (Christ's Resurrection) not only gives us hope for eternal life, but it also confirms that what Jesus said in his earthly life was true – that he would rise from the dead. If he hadn't, where would you and I, and all those we know and associate within the Church be today? If he hadn't, what hope is there for us to live in the light and glory of our living Lord, and with all those who've gone before us?

"But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead," Paul says (1 Corinthians 15:20). The resurrection was God's stamp of authenticity on Jesus, proclaiming to all the world, "Yes, Jesus is my Son. Yes, he has overcome sin, Satan, and death. Yes, what he told you is true. Trust him! Listen to him! And Follow him! "

In anticipation of our Easter celebration at OSL this year, you and your family are strongly encouraged to attend and participate in our Holy Week worship services (see dates and time in this newsletter), as well as attending our new Easter Vigil worship service on Saturday, March 30th, at 4:00 pm, in the Prayer Garden. This service will offer an opportunity for those interested and desire to "re-affirm" their baptism by full emersion. Just to be clear, this will not be a service of "re-baptism". Rather, it will be a service that will help us recall and reclaim the reality that we are cherished and beloved children of God when we were baptized, no matter how and how long ago that was. If you'd like to know more about the Lutheran practice of "re-affirmation of Baptism", please sign-up at the Welcome Desk, in the Narthex, or call the Church Office, and be sure to attend the class on Saturday, March 23, at 10:00 am in the Conference Room.

Beloveds of Jesus, I truly hope you will join us at all of the up and coming Worship opportunities that will be offered at OSL as we journey forward toward our Easter Sunday celebration. It's going to be powerful and life changing for the months ahead.





Remembering What We Were Made For: Just like many of you, I recently attended an Ash Wednesday service to mark the beginning of another Lenten season. The message of Ash Wednesday is an important reminder of our identity: that we are mortal beings created out of dust who will return to dust at the end of our natural lives. Even though we realize that God will resurrect the dead in faith to eternal life with him and

dust we will not remain, we cannot escape the present reality of the fleeting nature of our lives lived here on earth.

Prayer is a strong wall and fortress of the church; it is a goodly Christian weapon. ~ Martin Luther

The Lenten season draws us into deep reflection as to who we are, whose we are, and what we were made for. As followers of Jesus Christ, we acknowledge that our identity is shaped not by our accomplishments, wealth, social status, talents, or even our personality. Our identity is shaped by God: our creator, redeemer, and sanctifier. We belong to He who made us, redeemed us, and guides us in our daily living. But what exactly were we made for?


As Lutheran Christians we are fond of what Paul writes in Ephesians 2:8-9: "For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves; it is God's gift—not from works, so that no one can boast." These verses shaped the Reformation and emphasize that good works can never save us. It is God's grace that rescues us from sin, death, and the power of the devil. It cannot be earned; this ever will only be a free gift of God!

Yet we often miss the very next verse. Paul in Ephesians 2:10 continues: "For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared ahead of time for us to do." During these 40 days, I pray that we can remember again what we were created to do in this life we've been given to live on this earth. From the time that God breathed life into you until the time that your body returns to the earth, God has created and saved you for a purpose: to do good works!

So how is God calling you to steward your time, your gifts and abilities, your relationships, and your finances for the Kingdom? How is God calling you to return to the very basic life orientation of loving God and neighbor? A church member recently suggested that sometimes we forget that God is in charge; that He is Lord, and we are not. As we reflect this Lent on Jesus' journey to Jerusalem, the cross, and His sacrifice that saves us, may we also remember what we were made, and saved, for,
